

At the start of the meeting, we looked at some photos which had been sent by David (and which are now on the photo section of this website)

The main topic was farming and the information we had was supplemented by others present at the meeting. We focussed on farms within about 1 mile of the village centre – from Barrack Fold in the North West, – to Booth's Farm in the South East.

We looked at the information, photos and stories we had on Barrack Fold (which is believed to have been built in and which is thought to have been named because in 1642 there was an assembly on Cockey Moor in preparation for the attack on Bolton), Davenport Farm, Brown Hill, Dearden's Fold Farm, Old Barn Farm, Booth's and Plane Trees amongst others
