We continued looking at the industrial past of the village, focusing on the court case of Rylands v Fletcher, the ruling of which is reflected in court cases throughout the English Speaking world. This case was brought when, in 1860, the Redhouse Colliery mine was flooded by a reservoir built for a mill on the new road.
